Papers regarding production of the book MacDougall I, *Working Lives*, (Scottish Library Association, 1997), 1996.

Ian MacDougall left school at the age of 15, worked for some years on Newspapers and following his National Service graduated in History at Edinburgh University. He worked as a teacher and lecturer for over twenty years, much of that time at Newbattle Abbey College, before moving to work in public relations. He played a leading role in the foundation of the Scottish Labour History Society in 1961 and remained secretary of that group for 35 years. He is presently Secretary and research worker for the Scottish Working Peoples' History Trust.

He has published several books including *Labour Records in Scotland*, *Militant Miners*, *Essays in Scottish Labour History*, and a highly acclaimed series of oral history publications including *Hard Work*, *Ye Ken*, *Voices from the Spanish Civil War*, *Voices from Work and Home* and many others.

This small collection is made up of the working material for the book Working Lives (Scottish Library Association, 1997) which depicts working life through a series of photographs for the period 1897-1997, and was published to commemorate the centenary of the Scottish Trades Union Congress.

The collection has been arranged in five folders, each of which represent a different element in the production of the book from the first letters on the project to the proofs.
