Waldensian Missions Aid Society

Papers, 1865-1975, of the Waldensian Missions Aid Society, including annual reports, minutes, financial papers, and glass slides.

The Waldensian Missions Aid Society was founded before December 1866 in Edinburgh, and the Italian Evangelization Society was founded on 14 June 1850, as the Italian Evangelical Committee of Edinburgh. They merged late in 1898. The Society continues.
