DIARIES

Diaries kept as a student at Osnabrück (1-2) and throughout his military career, both in the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders (3-6) and subsequently when holding various senior appointments (6-14), and in retirement, until 1933 (15), when increasing blindness forced him to discontinue. Nos 3-15, which consist of groups of three or more diaries re-bound together as a single volume, contain also press-cuttings, snapshots and other ephemera pasted or tipped in.

RECOLLECTIONS

16. A lockable volume gold-stamped 'Private Diary' containing at the front, a record of his service 1897-1901 with additional entries written in at various times between 1902 and 1914, with a retrospect 1931 of events from 1872 to 1882 and further additions 1937, 1944; with snapshots, press-cuttings and other items pasted in throughout. At the back, inverted, are notes on officers ca.1904-ca.1908, and pasted in, a letter 1945 of Major-General Sir Edmund Hakewill-Smith.
17. A volume entitled 'Army Recollections Grave and Gay' containing typed reminiscences of his active career. Undated but written apparently not long after his retirement in 1919.

POCKET BOOKS

18. Notebook entitled 'Sporting Record' containing a record of game shot at various estates 1884-1911. A few snapshots of various houses and places are pasted in. Egerton's bookplate is pasted inside the front cover.
19. Notebook entitled 'Scraps odds and ends' containing mostly press-cuttings and a few snapshots pasted in 1882-95. His bookplate is pasted in towards the front.
20. Notebook entitled 'Scraps military' containing press-cuttings pasted in 1888-96, 1903. His bookplate is pasted in towards the front.
21. Apparently untitled notebook containing notes and extracts from printed sources copied in and some press-cuttings pasted in 1890-1912. His bookplate is pasted on the upper cover.
22. Untitled pocket book containing press-cuttings and some snapshots pasted in and some notes and memoranda copied in 1900-12. Bookplates of Egerton and the Green Howards Regiment pasted inside the front cover.
23. Notebook containing details of income and expenditure 1919-24.

CORRESPONDENCE

24. A volume consisting of letters of Egerton 1879-80, 1882 in the Afghan and Egyptian campaigns to members of his family, with notes in his hand on the flyleaves concerning the letters. His bookplate is pasted inside the front cover.
25. A volume containing letters of Egerton 1880-2 from Lucknow and Aden to members of his family with notes by him on the flyleaf. His bookplate is pasted inside the front cover.
26. A volume containing letters from Egerton during the Sudan campaign 1898 to his mother. His bookplate is pasted inside the front cover.
27. Miscellaneous correspondence 1879-1945, n.d., including single letters of Viscount Grey of Fallodon and Earl Beatty 1926, J.S. Haldane 1930 and copy of letter of J.E. Edmonds 1945.
