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Wardrop Papers

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Papers, nearly all formal documents, mostly relating to the lands of Foulshields and the families associated with them. The papers are principally those of the Wardrops and their heirs, the Scotts, but also include documents relating to Shaw, Kinloch, Baillie, Weir, and Carmichael families.

Documents relating to the lands of Foulshields, arranged by family.

SHAW

1. 1614, contract between Robert Shaw of Foulshields and Alexander Tindall of Torbain.
2. 1633?, decree concerning the lands of Foulshields, Mr Robert Linton against Robert Shaw.

KINLOCH

3. 1627, disposition and feu disposition, Patrick Kinloch to John and Henry Weir.
4. 1627, chapter of the lands of Foulshields, of Patrick Kinloch in favour of John and Henry Weir.
5. 1630-38, discharges of feu duties from Patrick Kinloch to Henry Weir.
