

Make your own Lighthouse



- Print out the A4 outline on thin white card or paper x2
Or you can print the second outline on coloured card

What you will need:

- Glue: Pritt-stick or similar works well
- Blu Tack or similar for the plastic items
- Craft Scissors - maybe get an adult to help you
- Felt pens or crayons. If you use Sharpies, be sure to protect the table
- The cardboard tube inside kitchen roll (clean), or a poster tube approx. 21cm high
- A selection of recycled plastic bottle tops, and larger tops off deodorant bottles or cans of shaving foam to make the lighthouse lamp
- A selection of recycled objects that might get washed up by the sea: fruit nets and maybe some shells or Lego
- String or coloured wool to use as ropes that have washed up

- The card should be thin enough to cut with scissors
- If you don't have card then you can use paper
- Colour in the stripes on one template, or you can cut out the stripes on one coloured sheet
- Glue the coloured stripes onto the white card template between the windows using the lines as a guide
- Wrap the template around the cardboard tube and glue down. You can use a rubber band to hold it whilst the glue dries
- Use Blu Tack or similar to fix the plastic 'lighthouse lamp' to the top of the cardboard tube
- If the tube is taller than the template then cut tabs to fold in
- Cut out the island base and colour in and attach lighthouse
- Glue the washed-up plastic or fruit nets onto the base. Add string and shells, or any Lego or buttons you might have
