Records of the Society, founded in March, 1761 to establish “proper regulations..amongst us for the better ordering and Government of our said Trade”; the Society had a continuous existence until its dissolution in June, 1873. The ‘Book of Records’ contains an unbroken run of minutes, and records of receipts and expenditure; a record of the deaths of members, 1763-1863, and membership lists, 1800-72 are at the rear of the main volume, and there is a separate series of folios of record, 1764-72, probably removed at some time from the volume.
